SAYING PLEASE

USUAL

mar pleg

literally, if it pleases

FORMAL

me a'th pÿs

literally, I pray you

ARCHAIC – now mostly used when pleading with someone **dell y'm kyrry**

literally, as you may love me

SAYING THANK YOU

USUAL

gromercy dhis

literally, grant mercy to you (compare French merci)

FORMAL

meur ras dhis (often shortened to just meur ras)

literally, much grace to you

COLLOQUIAL

dùrdala dhe jy

literally, may God pay to you
