

## SAYING PLEASE

USUAL

**mar pleg**

*literally*, if it pleases

FORMAL

**me a'th pÿs**

*literally*, I pray you

ARCHAIC – now mostly used when pleading with someone

**dell y'm kyrry**

*literally*, as you may love me

## SAYING THANK YOU

USUAL

**gromercy dhis**

*literally*, grant mercy to you (*compare French merci*)

FORMAL

**meur ras dhis** (often shortened to just **meur ras**)

*literally*, much grace to you

COLLOQUIAL

**dùrdala dhe jy**

*literally*, may God pay to you
