19:00 Yma Peternel ow tebry soper.

*Eth eur gordhuwher*

20:00 Yma Peternel ow redya. Yma hy ow redya *Jane Eyre*, lebmyn in Kernowek.

*Deg eur a'n nos*

22:00 Peternel yw sqwith. Yma hy ow cùsca i'n gwely.

**Myttyn** really means *early* morning rather than any time up to noon, and is best kept for the period before one starts the work of the day. (Monday to Saturday; or until matins on Sunday.) Note how **myttyn**, **dohajëdh** ‘afternoon’, **gordhuwher** ‘evening’ are both nouns and adverbs. But **dëdh** and **nos** are only nouns. The change **dëdh** > **a'n jëdh** is not a grammatical mutation, just an irregular sound-change applying specifically to this word.

**i'n scol** phr at school

**i'n gwely** phr in bed

**in chy** phr at home

*Note in chy is not traditionally interpreted as containing definite article an*

**lies** adj many (like the numerals **lies** is followed by a singular noun)

**class** m and **sport** m have the same meanings as in English
