Yma an lyfryow-na ow codha, Peder." Peder a wra aga hachya. In y dhorn yma dew lyver dâ. "Gwra miras, Morwena. Tas Gwydn a garsa redya an lyver-ma." Y whrowns y mos tre gans an dhew lyver.

Note

The verb-forms built with auxiliary **gwil** in this passage are *future* tense. Do not misunderstand them as present tense forms.
