So far we have learned to use Second State in the following circumstances:

- (1) Feminine singular noun after **an** 'the'
- (2) Attributive adjective after feminine singular noun
- (3) Feminine singular noun after **udn** 'one'
- (4) Any noun after **dew** or **dyw** 'two'

Here is a reference chart of the changes from First to Third State:

k	>	h						
qw	>	wh						That's a lot simpler than Second State mutation!
