Expressing **location** (including actions, which are treated as locations in Cornish)

*True locations*

**Yth esof vy in Weston-super-Mare.**

*I am in Weston-super-Mare.*

**Yth esta in Rësohen.**

*You are in Oxford.*

**Yma ev in Lulyn.**

*He is in Newlyn.*

**Yma hy in Penzans.**

*She is in Penzance.*

**Yma an gath in dadn an gwely.**

*The cat is under the bed.*

**Yth eson ny ryb an sarf.**

*We are beside the snake.*

**Yth esowgh why wàr an bord.**

*You (plural) are on the table.*

**Ymowns y adrëv an bara.**

*They are behind the bread.*

*Actions*

REMEMBER: **ow** is pronounced o' and **owth** is pronounced o'h

REMEMBER: **ow** is followed by Fourth State mutation

Mutation is reflected in the spelling. Here are the spellings that can change:

**b** > **p**

**d** > **t**

**g** > **k** before e, i, y

**q** before w

**c** before any other letter

**Yth esof vy ow redya.**

*I am reading.*

**Yth esta ow kerdhes.**

*You are walking.*

**Yma ev owth eva.**

*He is drinking.*

**Yma hy ow cùsca.**

She is sleeping.

**Yth eson ny ow neyja.**

We are swimming.

*Or flying – it needs a context*

**Yth esowgh why ow revya.**

You (*plural*) are rowing.

**Ymowns y ow marhogeth.**

They are riding.

**Yth esof vy ow qweles.**

I am seeing.

**Yth esta ow qwil.**

You am making / doing.

**Yma ev ow qwary.**

He is playing.

**Yma hy ow tos.**

She is coming.

**Yth eson ny ow ton.**

We are carrying.

**Yth esowgh why ow tebry.**

You (*plural*) are eating.

**Ymowns y ow tauncya.**

They are dancing.
