 for the Cornish words introduced in
CARA KERNOWEK BOOK ONE

Reconstruction for beginning of seventeenth century

The listing reflects a plausible reconstruction of Cornish as spoken at the beginning of the seventeenth century. Some handbooks specify sounds for revived Cornish that belong to other Celtic languages as they are spoken today. It is more likely, however, that for many centuries Cornish shared areal features with West Country English, especially the treatment of <r> as a retroflex (apical post-alveolar) approximant. The historical evidence also supports a distribution of voiceless sonorants that is uniquely Cornish.

Pronunciation should not depend on spelling

Each item is introduced first in Kernowek Standard (KS) spelling. But the accompanying IPA spelling is independent of Cornish orthography, so should apply equally if the item were spelled in, say, the Standard Written Form.

Stress patterns in compound words

In easily analysed compound words the stress belonging to each element is usually retained, with one element being slightly more prominent. In disyllabic compounds the primary stress tends to fall on whichever is the adjectival element; but many speakers automatically give greater prominence to the second element in a few compounds that may optionally be written as two separate words (e.g. pùptra for pùb tra), and in words built with causative/factitive -he. In plural forms the primary stress usually defaults to the penult.

Complex words built exclusively with affixes (closely bound prefixes, most suffixes, including plural markers) have a single stress accent; they are not treated as compound words. Chy is treated as a suffix in disyllabic words, and optionally as a suffix in words of more than two syllables.

Prosodic Shift

Laxing of vowels (the ‘Prosodic Shift’) is pervasive in words of more than one syllable; but there are some vowels, prefixes, whole words that resist it. And although stressed vowels in compound words often shorten, they (and some prefixes too) generally preserve their point of articulation.

Colouring by retroflex r

Quite apart from the Prosodic Shift, underlying stressed [ɛ] [ɪ] [ʊ] naturally tend towards [ə] [ɨ] [ʉ] respectively when immediately followed by [ɻ] or [ɻ̊]. This has been recognized explicitly in the listing.

Assimilation

Assimilation for a consonant cluster within a word, and also across the word boundary with a proclitic monosyllabic preposition or conjunction, is generally regressive; and does not operate on sonorants or glides. But [f], [θ], [x] (also when reduced to [h]) dominate their phonetic environment to produce voiceless clusters by both progressive and regressive assimilation, also operating on [l] and [ɻ]. If [v] or [ð] occur in a cluster, that sound too may be devoiced; [ɳf] may be substituted for [nv], and [fn̊] for [vn]. Prefix <an> becomes <af> before <l> and <r>; <bn> and <gn> are realized as [pn] and [kn].

Devoicing at end of monosyllables

There is a general tendency to devoice a voiced consonant at the end of a monosyllabic word, with shortening of the preceding vowel.

Other considerations

The following considerations have been left unmarked in the individual IPA spellings so as not to over-complicate them.

- (1) The coronal sounds [d] [t] [n] [ɳ] are alveolar. Some [ɻ] [ɻ̊] may be labialized. The labiodentals [f] [v] are sounded very lightly at the end of words.
- (2) The voiceless sounds [k] [t] [p] are aspirated, except when immediately preceded by [s] in the same word.
- (3) The voiceless sounds [ɳ] [ɸ] [ɻ̊] [ɻ] [m̊] are aspirated when immediately followed by a vowel in the same word, but this aspiration may be lost if the next syllable in the same utterance begins with the same aspirated consonant (dissimilation). It is however characteristic of Cornish as spoken today that [ɳ] [ɸ] [ɻ̊] are very frequently voiced to [n] [l] [ɻ] respectively. This development was already in progress in the later period of historical Cornish. It has been reinforced by the modern Standard Written Form, which does not recognize [ɳ] [ɸ] [ɻ̊] even when spelling the earlier texts. If voicing occurs in a cluster with [f] or [θ], these sounds become [v] and [ð].

- (4) [l] and [ɫ] are 'dark' in the same environments that velarize [l] in standard British English.
- (5) <bm> and <dn> are pronounced [m] and [n] by many speakers, and the spelling is then usually <mm> and <nn> respectively.
- (6) For some speakers [χ] is pronounced [h]; for some speakers it is silent though still causing devoicing of preceding [ɹ] to [ɹ̥].
- (7) Some speakers pronounce initial [s] as [z]. These speakers may also pronounce [z̥] as [z].
- (8) Some speakers may reduce [ɹθ] to [ɹ] and [ɹθ̥] to [ɹ̥].
- (9) Some distinguish [ə] and [ʌ], with distribution varying from speaker to speaker.
- (10) [ɔ] is generally realized without the strong lip rounding and higher tongue position characteristic of 'Received Pronunciation' in English.
- (11) [ɸ:] is realized by many speakers as an intermediate vowel, between [ɸ:] and [ə:] when followed immediately by [ɹ], and otherwise between [ɸ:] and [e:]. Some speakers shift the vowel all the way. [œ] is realized by many speakers as an intermediate vowel, between [œ] and [ə] when followed immediately by [ɹ], and otherwise between [œ] and [ɛ]. Some speakers shift the vowel all the way.
- (12) <oo> is pronounced [o:] by some speakers, which may be clipped to [o]. <ë> is pronounced [i:] by some speakers, which may be clipped to [i]; these usually change the spelling to <ÿ>. <êw> is pronounced [oʊ] by some speakers; these usually change the spelling to <ôw>. Conversely, <ôw> is pronounced [ɛʊ] by some speakers; these usually change the spelling to <êw>.
- (13) [ɛʊ] is pronounced [iʊ] by some speakers; others pronounce [iʊ] as [ɛʊ].
- (14) [oʊ] before a vowel in the same word is pronounced [u] by some speakers.
- (15) Final [i:] is pronounced [əɪ] by some speakers.
- (16) Wherever [i:] [i] [ɪ] are spelled <u> they are pronounced [y:] [y] [y̥] respectively by some speakers. When <u> immediately precedes another vowel in the same word it is universally pronounced [y]; contrast <ù> in this position, which is pronounced [u]. The listing below explicitly recognizes instances of [y:] [y] [y̥] that are widely employed to avoid ambiguity.

(17) Some speakers apply the English Great Vowel Shift to <a> in certain Cornish words, but not necessarily with diphthongization.

(18) Some speakers pronounce the first sound in preposition / conjunction / prefix <rag> as [ɹ̩].

Where a preposition is pronounced with a degree of stress, this has been marked as secondary on the basis the primary stress will be placed elsewhere in the utterance.

Be careful: not all devices display IPA symbols correctly

In particular, some devices such as i-Phones cause the near-close front unrounded vowel (IPA Number 319, Unicode U+026A) to display without the horizontal bars at top and bottom that properly belong to it.
