- C All entries, except pies and loaves, must be submitted on suitably sized paper plates
- D Cakes must be in clear plastic bags, where permitted, decorated cakes may be covered with clear plastic wrap. Cakes in cake keeper with opaque lids will not be judged or displayed
- E Muffin liners or any other wrappings used in baking must be removed
- F Standards for judging may be obtained from the local Department of Agriculture 250-398-4500
