TIPS FOR PLAYING QUICKLY

A quick pace does not mean you should rush your shots or run to your ball. We all enjoy golf for its social elements, plus giving each shot an appropriate amount of attention is crucial to playing well. Regardless of our handicaps, there are things each of us can do to speed up play. If we give and receive friendly reminders, we can finish in accordance with WGA Standing Rule 21 and USGA Rule 5.6. So, in each newsletter we are going to feature a couple of tips that can help us with our pace of play.

Simply put, seconds become minutes and minutes add up very quickly.

1. Play ready golf. Silence your cell phone. Don't talk or whisper while someone is hitting.

2. Be ready for your shot. When possible, determine your yardage and club selection while someone else is hitting.
