TEE TIME ADJUSTERS:

There have been questions on the ABCD groupings and the flights. The ABCD groupings are for tee times. The number of golfers signed up is divided into 4 groups based on indexes. Tee times and pairings are made based on these 4 groups. This is why you can be an A one week and a B the next week. It all depends on who signs up to play and their indexes.

When our scorecards are printed the field is divided into flights based on handicap. The goal is to have an even (or close to even) number of golfers in each flight with a maximum of 12 in each flight. This means on a day that is an individual game you may not be playing with someone that is in your flight. Here is an example based on actual numbers April 14. 56 golfers signed up, meaning that the ABCD split had 14 golfers in each split. When scorecards were printed there were 60 golfers signed up due to 4 late additions. 6 flights for scoring were created with 10 golfers in each flight. This meant that the bottom 5 golfers in the A group were in the 2nd flight and competing against the top golfers in the B group. The scoring flights may be adjusted after play due to additions and cancellations.

Handicap Rules for Hole started but not finished

There are various circumstances that might result in a player starting a hole but not holing out. For example, when:

The result of the hole has already been decided,

A hole has been conceded in match play,

A player's partner has already posted a better score in a Four-Ball format and the player pick up, or

A player has already reached their *net double bogey* limit on a specific hole.

When a player starts a hole but does not hole out for a valid reason, subject to other provisions set out within the *Rules of Handicapping,* the player must record their *most likely score* or *net double bogey,* whichever is lower, as appropriate for the situation and depending on the format of play.

The most likely score is:

HANDICAP:

The number of strokes already taken to reach a position on a hole, plus

The number of strokes the player would most likely require to complete the hole from that position, plus

Any penalty strokes incurred during play of the hole.

Most likely scores should be determined on any hole in accordance with the following guidelines:

Position of the Ball

If the ball lies on the putting green, and is no more than 5 feet:

If the ball lies between 5 and 20 yards from the hole:

If the ball lies more than 20 yards from the hole:

Strokes to be Added

Add one additional stroke.

Add 2 or 3 additional strokes, depending on the position of the ball, the difficulty of the green and the ability of the player.

Add 3 or 4 additional strokes, depending on the position of the ball, the difficulty of the green and the ability of the player.
