A new Worcester Bosch 8000 Life 45kw Heat boiler with a twelve-year part and labour guaranteed has been installed by G.N.S. Heating Ltd., of Ottery St Mary, at a cost of £2.871.00 excluding VAT. The price includes: re-run small sections of gas so that complete run is in 28mm, carry out Magna cleanse flush on heating system using Adey chemicals, installation of Honeywell Sundial 2 programmable timeclock and room thermostat, and remove old boiler and all rubbish.
