Lent



The Church encourages us to take on 3 activities during Lent that focus our attention on God, neighbour and ourselves: <u>*Prayer*</u> – strengthens our relationship with God; <u>*Fast*</u> – helps our personal spiritual life; <u>*Almsgiving*</u> – for the benefit of our neighbour.
