Lent begins at midnight of Ash Wednesday and officially ends at the start of the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday.

The Church encourages us to take on 3 activities during Lent that focus our attention on God, ourselves and neighbour: <u>Prayer</u> – strengthens our relationship with God; <u>Fast</u> – helps our personal spiritual life; <u>Almsgiving</u> – for the benefit of our neighbour.
