Pentecost Sunday 5 June

This feast of the gift of the Spirit is so significant for us, because it marks the handing on of Jesus' ministry to the Church. It also marks the fulfilment of our thoughts about baptism throughout this season: the gift of the Spirit which we receive in Confirmation is the 'seal' of our baptism, guaranteeing and confirming all that baptism achieves.
