

Week 1: Started on Tuesday 19th April, and it will take FIJ Building Service Ltd 26 weeks to finish.

Week 14: A meeting was held with the structural surveyor on Wednesday 27th July and some remedial solutions to the different problems were provided.

Week 15: The ground workers were expected to resume work on Tuesday 2nd August.

Week 16: The groundworkers worked Tuesday and Wednesday infilling the excavation with the mass Gen 3 concrete as requested by the Structural Engineer and they had to leave site until we know exactly what's happening with the existing drainage & what the new drainage strategy, design & layout for the project is.
