Week 1: Started on *Tuesday 19th April*, and it will take FIJ Building Service Ltd 26 weeks to finish.

Week 30: All external walls that are due to be removed have now been demolished. All major drainage works are now complete, with only the rainwater connections to be done after the new walls are built.

Week 31: Builders have been preparing the foundation for rebuilding, and Wales & West have done the diversion works of the gas pipe and installation of a new gas meter on the outside kitchen wall.
