- **Week 1:** Started on *Tuesday 19th April*, and it will take FIJ Building Service Ltd 26 weeks to finish.
- Week 34: New concrete slabs have been laid & the substructure blockwork has now been completed. The internal drain lining works have also successfully been installed.
- Week 34: The first phase of the steelwork installation commenced on Monday (12th). They stopped work on Wednesday. They hope to sort out the problem at the meeting with the Structural Surveyor on Monday (19th).
