### **The Catholic Bishops' Conference of England and Wales**

Have granted permission for the distribution of Holy Communion from the chalice to be resumed from Maundy Thursday onwards. It is each individual's choice whether to receive from the chalice or not; the Church teaches that the body, blood, soul and divinity of Christ is present in both the host and the precious blood, so there is no obligation to receive from the chalice. We cannot offer Communion from the chalice at St Anthony's because we haven't got any Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist yet. We'll have to wait until it's practical to comply.

### **The arrangements for Bishop Christopher's Requiem Mass are as follows:**

In accordance with Bishop Christopher's instructions, his body will be received into the Church of the Sacred Heart, Exeter at 5.00pm on Thursday 4th May. His Requiem Mass will take place at the Sacred Heart on the following day, Friday 5th May, at midday. Archbishop John Wilson will preside.
