

Has been received from CAFOD for the £50 donation sent to them from the Parish in May. A donation certificate has been received from the Order of Augustinian Recollects with grateful thanks for the donation of £705.00 sent to them in April for the Sierra Leone Mission.

Message received from Dorrie and Tony Madden's son Paul on 13th June:

"Thank you very much for visiting Tony. He told me how much he appreciated it. It has obviously been a difficult time for him".

"My Mum's funeral is on Friday this week and the interment at Ottery Cemetery will be next Monday. After that, we are taking Dad to a new care home, five minutes from our house in Surrey. It will be sad for him to leave Ottery, where he has spent 84 of his 94 years. But it means he will be able to see us almost every day, so he is looking forward to that".

"I thought I would let you know that I am planning to bring him to Mass at St Anthony's on Sunday for the last time before he leaves Ottery. It will have special memories for him as that is where he married my Mum, 71 years ago".

"I'm not sure if you knew, but I think the reason he is called Tony, is probably because the church in Granadilla, Tenerife, where his parents were married, and where he was baptised, is the Iglesia San Antonio de Padua. So churches of St Anthony have always played a significant part in his life!"
