**Week 1:** Started on *Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> April 2022*, and it will take FIJ Building Service Ltd 26 weeks to finish.

**Week 62:** The remainder of the steelwork was successfully installed and the carpenters were able to proceed with roof works over the Proposed Lobby, the sacristy and the church North wing.

**Week 63:** Work has been progressing slowly. We might see the lobby roof, the sacristy roof and the North wing extension roof covered this coming week.
