Yes, I will show those figures within the Running Final Account Schedule. You need to remember these works were originally priced some two years ago & both labour & material prices have gone up substantially since then as can be seen from the recent electrical & plumbing quotes received.

We are still awaiting details from your architectural designer as per the attached schedule, however, we will look to go back and fit the windows & doors as soon as they become available from Woodley's Joinery & we are also looking to get the external rendering works booked in, in around 6 to 8 weeks' time.

We cannot make a meaningful return to site until the electrical & plumbing works have all been resolved & all outstanding information received from your architectural designer. Once we have all of this, we can look to re-price & re-programme the remaining works.
