# Appointment of Parish Safeguarding Representative to St Anthony's

Michelle Monahan-Little has been appointed as our second Safeguarding Representative by the Diocesan Safeguarding Commission. This appointment will initially be for a six-month period in accordance with national policy. Towards the end of this period, the Diocesan Safeguarding Commission will get in contact with everyone to review the appointment, and if these are successful, they will then be confirmed in this role for a period of three years, at which time this will once more be reviewed.
