Week 13 managed by Parish: The plasterers will finish their work by Friday this coming week. They were absent from St Anthony's most of last week. The decorator/painter has already started painting the ceiling and the walls. The electricians have restored the power to the South wing and the new area above the altar. Two carpenters will continue working on doors, windows, ceilings, walls, etc. Good to know that we are moving forward in the right direction and soon we'll be able to tear down the partition and take over the whole church.
