Gift Aid audit

The diocese has carried out an audit on St Anthony's parish gift aid. A sample of collections that formed the basis of the tax claim was selected from OPAS and traced to the original records (or cash sheets/bank statements). A sub-sample of these records was traced to weekly envelopes. No errors were found.

These records were examined to assess whether the parish has complied with the requirements of the GASDS scheme with respect to cash counting and recording. There was no error in the GASDS tax claim.
