Phase 2 project at St Anthony's!

Started on Tuesday 19th April 2022, managed by FIJ Building Service Ltd, and was expected to be finished in 26 weeks. After 94 weeks on *Friday 19th January* FIJ Building Service Ltd. offered to end their involvement and passed it on to the Parish to carry on the building project and see it come to a happy end.

Week 14 managed by Parish: At last on Saturday 11th May the newly refurbished and extended St Anthony's was opened for the 6.00pm Mass congregation.

Gift Aid audit

The diocese has carried out an audit on St Anthony's parish gift aid. A sample of collections that formed the basis of the tax claim was selected from OPAS and traced to the original records (or cash sheets/bank statements). A sub-sample of these records was traced to weekly envelopes. No errors were found.

These records were examined to assess whether the parish has complied with the requirements of the GASDS scheme with respect to cash counting and recording.

There was no error in the GASDS tax claim.
