





Is A Cricut The Same As A Laser Cutter?

- No
- More affordable than a laser cutter
- Can't cut material thicker than 2.4 mm
- Uses a physical blade or tool instead of a laser
- Much slower than a laser cutter



Cricut or Silhouette?

- Cricut software is easier to use
- Silhouette software can do more complex things
- Silhouette software is much more complex to learn
- Otherwise the machines are very similar in overall capabilities



Overview Of Blades & Tools:

- Machine comes with basic cutting tool, called the fine-point blade
- It holds a tool in Clamp A and a tool in Clamp B
- Different tools only work with certain materials or perform certain actions
- Machine knows what tool is loaded
- The software will tell you when to install a different tool or blade
- Maker can use all the tools, but some are not compatible with the Explore
- Joy has it's own unique tools







Maker Tools

Knife Blade: For thick & strong materials

Engraving Tip: For engraving

Rotary Blade: For cutting fabric & delicate materials

Debossing Tip: Similar to embossing

Perforation Blade: Cuts a perforated cut line

Double Scoring Wheel: Makes a double score line

Single Scoring Wheel: Makes a single score line

Wavy Blade: Cuts a wavy line

Maker & Explore Tools

Fine-Point Blade: Standard cutting blade

Deep-Point Blade: Slightly bigger than standard blade

Bonded Fabric Blade: For cutting bonded fabric **Foil Transfer Kit**: For foil embossing pressure foil

Joy Tools

Joy Foil Transfer Kit: For foil embossing

Joy Blade: Standard cutting blade


- Leave space around machine for mat to move in and out
- Follow the steps in the booklet

Cricut Software: Design Space (DS)



- Cricut machines can only run on DS
- You have to complete the project in DS
- You don't have to design the project in DS
- DS allows uploading
- Purchase or design your own SVG files
- Upload the project, only have to use DS to send it to the Cricut



Make Your Own SVG Designs!

- Designing a project in DS is very limiting
- Work in a graphics program that works with SVG files
- Adobe Illustrator, Corel Draw, Inkscape, Gimp,
 & Vectornator are all good options
- Personally I'd recommend Inkscape, it's free, easy to use, and works great



So what's an SVG?

SVG: Scaleable Vector Graphic

- It's an image format, like a jpeg or png
 - They look the same but they're not interchangeable when it comes to DS
- You can't easily convert an image to an SVG
- You can upload other file types and use the editing tools, but it's not great
 - Uploading PNG is better, but SVG is best

No SVG? No Project File? No Problem!

What About Working With Your Own Materials?

- Cricut brand materials work best with the factory calibrated material settings
- Any materials designed for these machines will work, including the silhouette ones
- You may need to adjust the settings if it's not the Cricut brand material
- You can make a custom material setting to cut something not made for the Cricut
- Always monitor the machine through the cut

Use caution cutting a custom material for the first time! This can seriously damage the machine.


