 3. Financial need must be demonstrated.
 4. Scholastic ability must be shown, but it is not necessary to be an Honor Roll Student.
 5. Must demonstrate contributions to school and/or community and home.
Must reflect the goals of the Woman's Club as in our Statement of Purpose.
 6. Scholarship must be used to further one's education.
 7. Scholarship will be awarded for second semester.
