



Privacy Policy

General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) is the European Privacy legislation that ensures your personal data is protected even better than before. Transparency about the use of your data becomes more important every day. Therefore, Irish Flight Training Ltd Privacy Policy is in full compliance with EU and national legislation to meet all requirements.

What data does Irish Flight Training Ltd collect and store?

We only collect and store data relating to the business relation with the individual person training at Irish Flight Training Ltd. This includes, but is not limited to:

- (a) Personal details: Name, citizenship, date of birth, gender, address
- (b) Licensing details: License number, state of issue, ratings, expiry dates, applicable medical certificates
- (c) Training details: The contents of your training records such as assessments, skill test reports, certificates

We actively minimize the amount of data we collect, as part of our code of conduct required by the GDPR.

How long does Irish Flight Training Ltd store my data?

Only as long as the business relation is running. For some, the data retention period is longer, as required by the regulatory authorities through EU regulation 278/2011, EASA Part-FCL.

All student records shall be kept for a minimum period of five (5) years after completion of the training.

The records on the qualifications and training of instructional and examining staff shall be retained for a minimum period of five (5) years after the instructor or examiner ceases to perform a function for the training organisation.

Does Irish Flight Training Ltd share personal data?

Personal data is only shared with other entities in specific cases, and only with consent of the individual. Such entities include national Civil Aviation Authorities, or airlines when they have sponsored training.

Personal data is never shared with other entities for marketing purposes.
