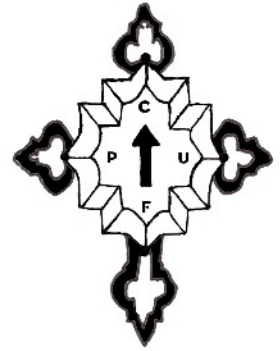

Three families from each of our four churches will be selected each year. Each family selected will receive a certificate and a gift from the Council. Selection will be based on the following:

3. Does the family attend weekly Mass together?

5. Has the family made significant contributions to the parish and church community?
6. Does the family serve as a role model of Catholic family values?
7. Recommendation from the Parish Pastor.
