

Frank Gerbes Jr. was born on Mother's Day, in 1950 to Frank Gerbes, Sr. and Helen Gerbes in Newburgh, New York. He has an older sister Helene and two younger brothers, Paul and Steven. His Baptism at St. Francis of Assisi began his lifelong dedication to the Church. After attending St. Francis Elementary School and St. Patrick's High School he received his B.S. in Marketing from Marist College. In 1966, he traveled to St. Patrick's Cathedral in New York City to receive the Cardinal Spellman Youth Award, and he met the love of his life, Mary. They married 50 years ago on August 28, 1971 and were blessed with a son Jody Edward, (his wife Kristi and two grandchildren, Jackson and Elle,) a daughter Joy, (her husband Brian Conneally and three grandsons, Nolan, Luke and Braden, currently living in Park City, Utah, and daughter Fay (and husband Asher Pacht and one grandchild, Miryam.)
