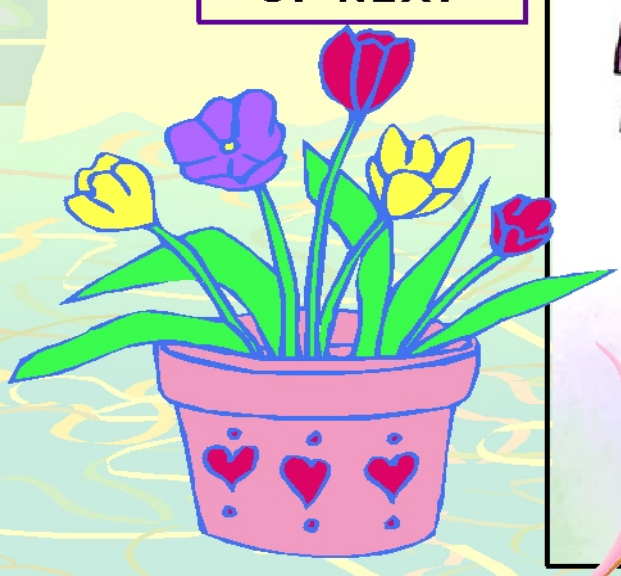

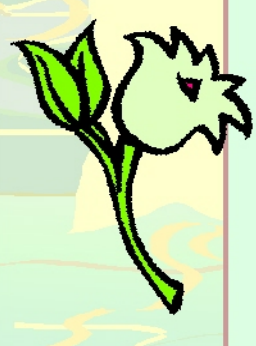

President's Message



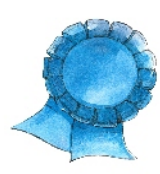
Dear Members,

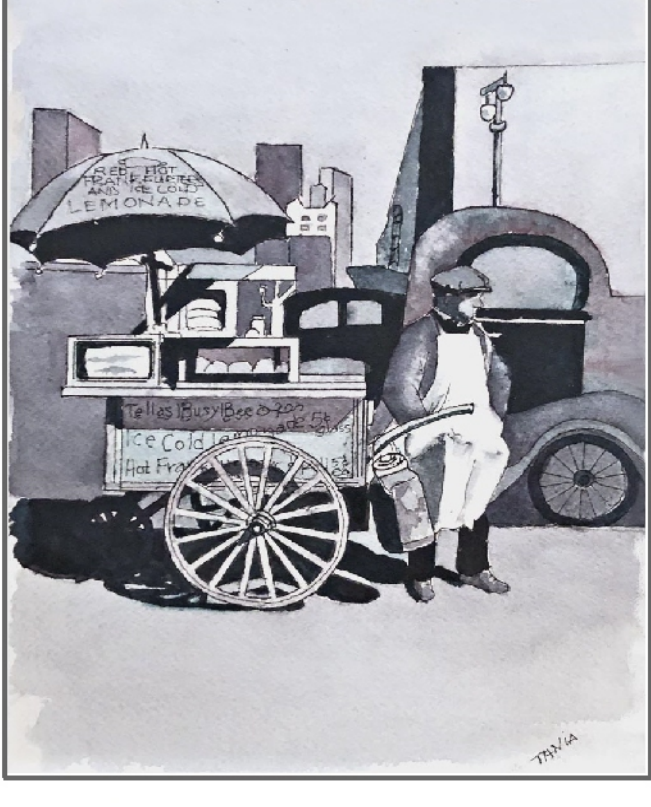

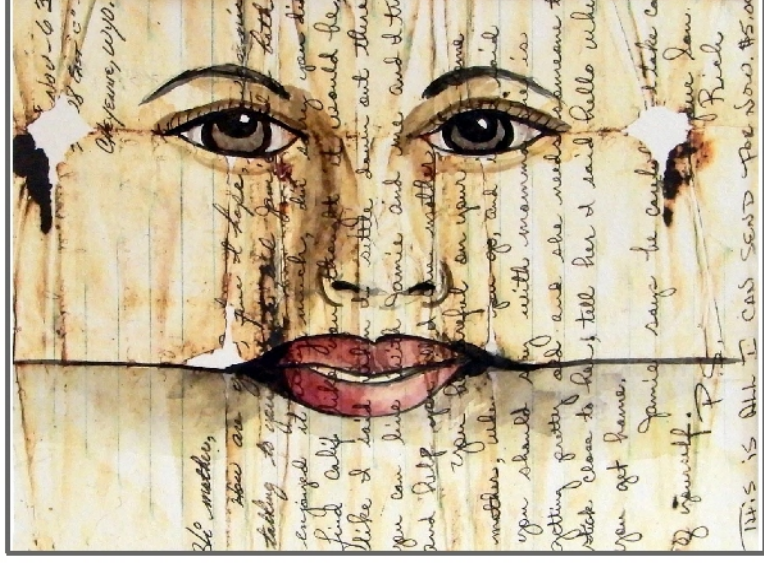
