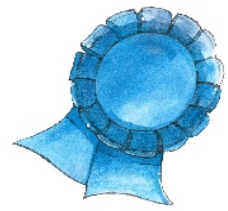

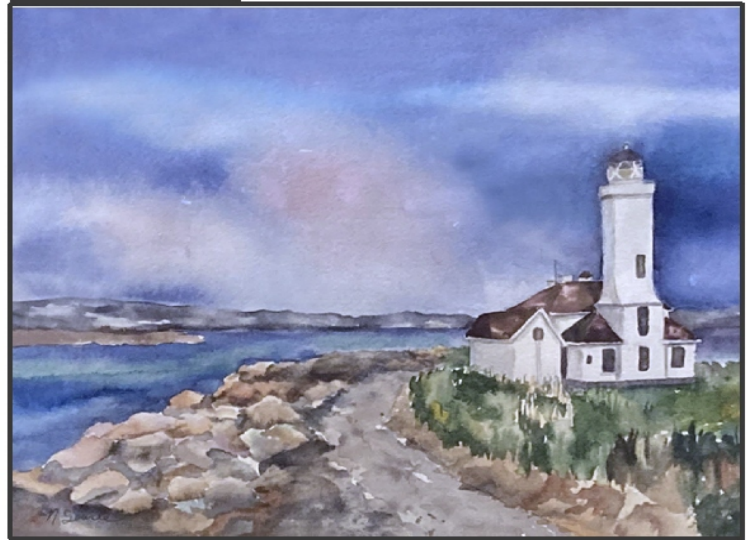

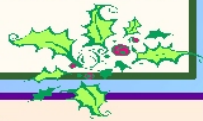

Holiday MEETING RECAP

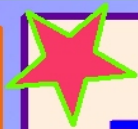


(Dmitry's watercolor painting)
