



## 2024 BAS Paint-Out Day & Dinner





### MEETING RECAP



Guest artist and oil painter, Paul Kratter had us laughing from the start. He told us many stories (most of them funny), having to do wth his life as a plein air painter, as he painted this lovely landscape (at left) and also explained his process from start to finish. Using a fairly minimal palette, he was happy to tell us all about his color mixes and answer any question we through at him. Paul does not paint on traditional stretched canvas, but instead paints on linen covered Gatorfoam panels made by a

company called New Traditions Art Panels Inc., which are very light weight, easy to transport and to deal with when painting outdoors. He does not use paint mediums, only Turpenoid. Paul shared his all important sketch books, along with many other completed paintings that he brought along for us to see and potentially purchase. He was very generous, as he gifted three of his sketches (torn right out of his personal sketch books) along with his demo painting of that day, to four lucky BAS members, although there was a small price to pay.....the price for each was a kiss on the cheek.....
