History

This property belonged in the middle of the 19th century to Mr. Armand ROUX, negociant at Pauillac. Having no descendants, he offered the estate to the village of Vertheuil. A few years later it was sold to build a hospital, which became a military hospital during the 2 World Wars. Domaines FABRE purchased this historical estate in 1976.

-  Firmly structured on the palate with a velvety finish.

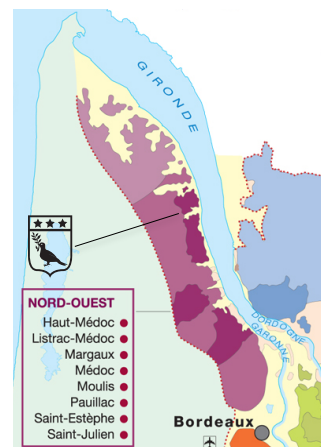

AOC Specifics

The Haut-Médoc appellation stretches some 52 km (37 miles) from north to south. It has terroirs of remarkable quality, with a pre-dominance of layers of (essentially Garonne) gravel, deposited in outcrops, these sites are all characterized by their wide diversity. It is the homeland of Cabernet Sauvignon grapes. The vines live on since 2000 years thanks to the passion of the winemakers.
