History

Fabre on the Rocks strays from the traditional path of the Bordeaux wine region. Say goodbye to Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot and make way for Malbec! We have planted this traditonal grape variety on a hill where it flourishes beautifully. The limestone pebbles are scattered around the soil of this particular part of the vineyard. We wanted Fabre on the Rocks to be both juicy and delicious, a rebellious wine to be enjoyed during simple moments of sharing. Thus, the wines fresh and fruity taste were preferred over its oak flavour. A wine that is to be enjoyed in its youth.



A wine that respects the freshness of the fruit and the density of the malbec

The Haut Médoc appellation stretches some 52 km (37 miles) from north to south. It has terroirs of remarkable qualiy, with a pre-dominance of of (essentially Garonne) layers gravel, deposited in outcrops, these sites are all characterized by their wide diversity. It is the homeland of Cabernet Sauvignon grapes. The vines live on since 2000 years thanks to the passion of the winemakers.



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
