Temporary Covid-19 Travel Restrictions for Germany

From 2021-09-02

In compliance with the still valid general entry requirements for the Federal Republic of Germany, the following <u>additional</u> entry restrictions apply in the context of the Covid-19 pandemic.

A. <u>Direct Airside Transit</u>

No restrictions

Please be aware of the confirmed onward ticket to the next non-Schengen country and possible Covid-19 related entry restrictions at the final destination.

B. Entry to remain in Germany

No restrictions for

- a) EU nationals and nationals of Schengen states
 b) GBR nationals holding a Withdrawal Agreement residence document issued
 by an EU country or a Schengen state
- Third country nationals holding a residence permit or visa type D issued by an EU country or a Schengen state

Visa type D: Residence is required! Not for the first entry to establish residency

- Core family member of nationals mentioned under No. 1 and No. 2
 Spouse or registered partner, minor unmarried children and parents of minors
- Holders of an official letter issued by a DEU mission confirming urgent travel needs
- Residents of ALB, AND, ARM, AUS, AZE, BIH, BRN, CAN, HKG, KOR, JOR, LBN, MAC, MCO, MDA, MKD, NZL, QAT, SAU, SGP, SRB, SMR, TWN, UKR, VAT, XXK. A person is considered a resident of a country if they have their domicile or habitual residence there, specifically if they have spent the past 6 months there
- Fully vaccinated travellers (as of 25th of June). This does NOT apply for residents of China
 - Unvaccinated children under 12 years of age are allowed to enter Germany if they travel with at least one fully vaccinated parent.
 - o Proof of vaccination:
 - i. In digital (e.g. EU Digital COVID Certificate) or paper form (e.g. WHO vaccination booklet) in German, English, French, Italian or Spanish

- ii. The vaccine used must be one of those listed on the website of the Paul-Ehrlich-Institut
- iii. A period of at least 14 days must have elapsed since receiving the last vaccine dose.

(Travellers who recovered from Covid-19 need to proof receiving of one dose of vaccine)

Exemptions according to the purpose of travel, role of the traveller, or other <u>urgent need to travel</u>. Sufficient proof shall be submitted by the passenger.

- Planed marriage to national residing in DEU
- Urgent family reason like birth, funeral, serious illness, wedding
 Applies to all first-grade and second-grade relatives, core family and adult children, grandparents, parents of adult children, grandchildren, siblings
- Unmarried couples

Third country national visits a partner living in Germany

- Steady partnership with national mentioned under No. 1 or No. 2
- Invitation and passport copies of the partner living in DEU
- Signed declaration "Selbsterklärung Besuch des Partners"
- Proof of previous meeting
 e.g. entry/exit-stamps, flight tickets, registration of common residence, photos, social media, letters)

Couple lives abroad

- Steady partnership with national mentioned under No. 1
- Proof of urgent travel reason like under No. 8
- Proof of common residence abroad
- Signed declaration "Selbsterklärung gemeinsame Reise"
- Serious medical reasons e.g. live-saving treatment or ongoing treatment which can only be performed in Germany or at least cannot be received in the country of residence
- Urgent business reasons
 - Skilled and highly qualified workers
 Proof of employment and the need of being present in DEU
 Work cannot be postponed or carried out from abroad
 - Scientists / researchers
 - Healthcare professionals e.g. Nurses, Doctors, Pharmacists

- Business travelers e.g. executives and employees signing contracts or maintenance of industrial products can be proven by the form "Erklärung zur unbedingten Erforderlichkeit einer kurzfristigen Geschäftsreise"
- IT-Specialists
- Transport personnel
- Seasonal workers in agriculture
- Exhibitors confirmation of fair organizer
- Trade fair visitors with admission ticket <u>and</u> a confirmation from an exhibition exhibitor about an appointment on-side
- Participants of a congress with invitation <u>and</u> proof of the organizer that the congress will not take place online
- Seamen on duty
- Students
 - Admission to study of the university or employer
- Trainees, advanced education for at least 6 month with confirmation of the employer that presence in DEU is needed
- Diplomats, military members, staff of international organizations on duty, on the way to their mission country or return
- Core family member of diplomats from countries mentioned under No. 1 a)
- Au-pairs and volunteers for at least a 6 month stay
- Professional athletes for competitions or tournaments, including attendants
- Amateur athletes for training or competitions for Olympic and Paralympic Games or for participation in tournaments being delegated by a national sports federation
- Sports officials for international sports events
- Referees of competitions or tournaments

C. Entry for the purpose of transit to a Schengen or EU country

 Current printout of the entry regulations of the country of final destination, which proofs that the country of residence is excluded from the entry restrictions.

Alternatively.

passengers mentioned under chapter B. The same entry conditions apply.

- Holder of an official letter, issued from the country of final destination and stating that entry will be granted, will not have to submit further proof.
- Possible Covid-19 related easing of travel restrictions shall be proven by the passenger.

D. Entry for the purpose of transit to a third country state

- o Onward flight ticket to a non-Schengen airport
- Submission of proof that the entry in the third country state is permitted
- Current printout of the entry regulations of the transiting countries which proofs that the transit to a non-Schengen country is allowed.
