Services: There is a **morning** service each Sunday at 10:30am. **Informal Communion** is held on the first Sunday of the month at the end of the service, except May & November when a **Formal Communion** is held during the normal service. The Church has an **induction loop system**, which allows people with a hearing aid to participate more fully in the services. Use is also made of a **projection system** during the services.
