play area. The classroom furniture, which is still in very good condition has been taken from the church to the Kindergarten. The increase in space and facilities will be enjoyed.



We cannot believe that 10 years have passed since the work of Care for Kaleo started. It was 2004 when we received a phone call from our son Andy who was with VSO in Kaleo. The Baptist church had collapsed during a violent storm "Can you help?" Since then so much has happened; it has been a partnership between us in the UK, Pastor Solomon Bagonluri and his wife Rebecca in Kaleo and God. In 2004 we shipped out building machinery and sent a technician to provide training in using the machinery and building techniques. That

was the year of our first visit to Kaleo and we then understood the need that was in the villages of the Upper West Region of Ghana. Also, God touched our hearts and we knew we had to get involved. Ten years on and there is now a very substantial new Church building, a Sunday School and a Kindergarten. The Primary School is the current project which will, when completed, give children a total of 8 years of quality education along with a daily hot meal. All we can do is thank God and thank you for your wonderful generosity.

## PRIMARY SCHOOL BUILDING STARTED
