Obedience Regulations

These regulations apply to all obedience events licensed by The Kennel Club of Jersey (the KCJ). Obedience events must follow The Kennel Club Limited (UK) Obedience Show Regulations (G) ("Reg G) save for the subsequent exceptions:

- 1. Where Reg G states Board this is to be read as the KCJ Executive Committee, where it states Kennel Club this is to be read as the KCJ as appropriate.
- 2. Licences will be issued by the KCJ following application for a licence and approval by the Executive Committee.
- 3. All event organisers issued with licences agree to adhere to the KCJ Constitution, Regulations & Codes.
- 4. Dogs taking part in the event must be registered with either the KCJ or the Guernsey Kennel Club.
- 5. The event organiser will be responsible for deciding the eligibility of all dogs competing at the event.
- 6. Persons disqualified or suspended by the KCJ or any organisation with which the KCJ has a reciprocal agreement is held will not be eligible to take part in any event.
- 7. Guarantors are not required for events licenced by the KCJ.
- 8. The wins of Channel Island competitors up to and including Class B at the KCJ licensed shows are included when assessing eligibility for classes in the UK. Class C wins at the KCJ licensed shows are not included when assessing eligibility for Class C in the UK. The wins of UK citizens at KCJ licensed shows do not count when assessing eligibility for any classes in the UK. The wins of any competitor-at The Kennel Club Limited (UK) licensed shows are included when assessing eligibility for classes at events held in Jersey.
- 9. Objections, disqualifications, forfeit of awards and fines will be dealt with by the event organisers with the KCJ acting as arbiter in accordance with its Constitution. Rule 12 of Reg G details the information required to lodge an objection.

- 10. A competitor may act as a Steward (with the exception of the role of Chief Steward) in a class in which they are not competing. The Chief Steward requirements at G(E) 1a are not applicable, however the Chief Steward should have a sound knowledge of the Rules, Reg G and KCJ Obedience Regulations.
- 11. The event organiser is responsible for all matters related to the running of an event, including the appointment of judges.
- 12. Reg G32d, (Experience required for Open Judges) does not apply for Novice Class and below. A judge appointed for these classes must have worked a dog and won out of Class B.
