The Agriculture Value Chain Development Project (AVDP) will be implemented over six years with the overall goal of improving livelihoods, food security and climate resilience of rural farming households. The project will be financed by IFAD, the Adaption Fund, OPEC Fund for International Development (OFID), the private sector, the Government of Sierra Leone (GoSL) and beneficiaries.

Project Goal

Improve livelihoods, food security and climate change resilience rural farming households in Sierra Leone.

Project Beneficiaries

The AVDP will target an estimated 43,000 direct beneficiaries and their families, thereby reaching a total of 258,000 people.
