Background

The Smallholder Commercialization and Agribusiness Development Project will be implemented over a period of **x** years with the overall goal of promoting smallholder commercialization by fostering productive business linkages between smallholder farmers and selected agribusiness firms and other commodity off-takers in Sierra Leone. The project is funded by the International Development Association (IDA) (US\$40 million – 72.7%) through an IDA Credit provided to the Government of Sierra Leone, and the UK's Department for International Development (DFID) (US\$15 million – 27.3%) through a client-executed Trust Fund to be managed by the World Bank.

Project Goal

Promote smallholder commercialization by fostering productive business linkages between smallholder farmers and selected agribusiness firms and other commodity off-takers in Sierra Leone.

Project Beneficiaries

The project will directly benefit 50,000 smallholder farmers, of which 40% will be women and youth farmers.
