## PRODUCT DATA SHEET

<b>Product</b>	<b>Glass Cleaner</b>
<b>Type</b>	Glass cleaner.
<b>Intended Use</b>	Cleaning glass. Use on wood, coal or oil burning stoves, glass fire screens or fronts.
<b>Special Features</b>	It clings to vertical surfaces, to quickly dissolve smoke stains and tar/creosote deposits.
<b>Preparation</b>	Ensure that the surface to be cleaned is cool. Shake glass cleaner vigorously to build up foam before use.
<b>Application</b>	Apply to the area to be cleaned and leave for up to 5 minutes. (Foam will coat the surface initially, although during a 5-minute time laps, this will run off, so it is recommended that protection is laid down to protect this). Wipe off with a damp cloth, rubbing gently. Polish with an absorbent cloth or tissue. If stubborn stains remain, repeat using a nylon scouring pad.
<b>Coats</b>	Re-apply when required.
<b>Drying Time</b>	5 minutes.
<b>Re-coating Time</b>	N/A
<b>Application Temp.</b>	Cool.
<b>Coverage</b>	N/A
<b>Maintenance</b>	Store in a cool, dry place.

<b>Hazards</b>	Extremely flammable: Keep out of reach of children.
