Event goals:

1. Promotion of modeling as a way of spending free time.
2. Popularizing modeling among the inhabitants of the region, with particular emphasis on children and youth.
3. Exchange of experiences between modellers of different ages.
4. Promotion of the city of Nowy Targ and the Podhale region.

Festival plan:

STATUTE

1. The Modeling Festival in Nowy Targ is a festival-exhibition. It is an open event and both individual and group modellers can participate.
2. The condition for participation in festivals/competition is to register models using the Modeling Event Service System - **SCALE MODELING** . Submitting a model to the competition is tantamount to accepting the regulations. Persons registering more than one person from one e-mail address (modeling clubs, modeling workshops) are obliged to present, at the request of the organizer, a list of participants so that the organizer can confirm the person's data.
3. Entry fees **PLN 20** , juniors and youngsters **are not charged** .
4. Models that have received distinctions (including special distinctions) in previous editions of CIUPAGA cannot be submitted for evaluation again.
5. Those interested in participating in the modeling fair are asked to make a reservation by May 10, 2024, the stands are subject to payment to the organizer. After this date, the organizers do not guarantee a place for trading.
6. The participant may exhibit any number of models, but no more than 5 pieces in each category.
7. In the case of Cardboard Models, there is no division into age categories and scale, it is an **OPEN category**
8. Age categories, determined by year of birth:
 - HONIELNIK i.e. YOUNGER (players up to 12 years old)
 - JUHAS i.e. JUNIOR (players from 13 to 18 years old)
 - BACA i.e. SENIOR (players over 18 years old)
9. In case of doubts as to the authorship of the model or the participant's age in relation to the age category, the judges have the right not to evaluate it and to disqualify the participant.
10. If the model is not attached to the stand, please provide the description: **"MODEL NOT FIXED TO THE STAND"**

11. Attaching documentation to the model is not obligatory, but recommended in the case of indexed models and models built from scratch.
12. The organizers plan to award three equal distinctions in each class. In the case of a high level of model performance, the number of distinctions may be increased. Similarly, in the event of a low level of performance, the number of awards may be reduced by the Organizers. The number of distinctions in a given class is decided by the Chief Judge and the Organizers.
13. The Festival organizers do not enter models into competitions in accordance with the principle: "You organize - You judge - You do not submit for evaluation"
14. The organizers may exhibit their works in the non-assessment category - exhibition only. Persons directly related to the organization of the competition cannot enter models in the competition.
15. ***We pick up the models at the time designated by the ORGANIZER, i.e. 1:30 p.m.*** If you want to pack the model in advance, please contact the organizer.
16. When taking the model from the competition, please hand over the entry cards to the people designated to help with the competition. as well as showing cards confirming that the person is taking their models.
17. People who do not comply with **the REGULATIONS** will receive appropriate warnings during the competition, and information about people who break or do not comply with the above-mentioned regulations will be provided to other competition organizers.

II

RULES FOR EVALUATING ENTERED MODELS

1. The Chief Judge is appointed by the Organizers before the competition.
2. The Chief Judge and the organizer appoint judges' committees to evaluate the appropriate categories and perform general supervision over the work of the

judges' committees, the judges are members of the Nowy Targ Modeling Group as well as judges invited by the organizers (a judge is allowed to participate in the competition after prior arrangement between the organizer and the judge Main).

3. The models submitted to the competition are assessed by judges appointed by the organizers according to the "like it - don't like it" principle. The decision of the judging panel is final and is not subject to protest.
4. In the absence of a judge (random cases), the organizer may appoint a reserve judge from experienced festival participants. **ATTENTION** – There is a rule that models should not be judged by a judge competing in a given starting class.
5. The judging results are confirmed by the Chief Judge, distinguished models are marked on the cards under the model.
6. The decisions of the judging panel are made public on the day the festival ends.
7. The judging panels will consist of at least: 3 people.
8. A participant can only take **one of the awarded places in a given class** . The highest-rated model made by the participant will be taken into account.
9. During the evaluation, the judging panel will pay particular attention to:
 - *careful workmanship and geometric correctness*
 - *the complexity of the model*
 - *painting and marking (does not apply to cardboard models)*
 - *contribution of own work*

ATTENTION! *If the valorized part of the model is hidden inside the model, the modeler who wants to draw attention to the valorization should attach photographic documentation from the stage of building the valorization.*

9. People from younger age groups are allowed to compete in older categories (e.g. Honielnik exhibits his works in the Juhas category), the reverse situation is unacceptable (does not apply to cardboard models).
10. The organizers do not provide insurance for models, participants and visitors.
11. Models are delivered and collected at the participants' own expense.
12. The organizers provide special prizes, SPECIAL CATEGORY Memorial to Captain Tadeusz Schiele - "Nojpiykniyjsy Polowac", i.e. the most beautiful fighter with a checkered pattern.

SPECIAL CATEGORY regulations:

1. A participant may submit **one model** .
2. Any type of aircraft can be submitted to the memorial.
3. Plastic and cardboard models can compete.
4. Documentation required but not necessary.
5. Without division into scale and type.
6. The assessment is made by **Grupa Modelarska Nowy Targ**
7. The evaluation of the models will be carried out on the basis of **IPMS POLSKA points**.
8. Featured models will receive 1st, 2nd and 3rd places, and will receive special awards and diplomas.
