INSTRUCTOR INDEMNITY

PROFESSIONAL LIABILITY PUBLIC LIABILITY PRODUCT LIABILITY

This policy provides an indemnity to an instructor for liability arising from their instruction, demonstration or supervision of Martial Arts activity including legal defence costs.

Important - All persons, who teach or supervise, must arrange this cover (minimum age at application is 18 years). All instructors must have a recognised qualification or confirm black belt or equivalent has been obtained.

Instructors public & products liability insures your legal liability to pay compensation to members of the public if they are injured or their property is damaged as a result of an accident caused by you, or caused by advice or instruction given by you.

MEMBER TO MEMBER LIABILITY GENERAL THIRD PARTY PUBLIC LIABILITY

This policy provides indemnity for your legal liability for damages including legal costs arising out of accidental injury to any person (other than employees) accidental loss or damage to third party property nuisance and trespass and member to member liability.
