SHOW RULES

- 1 Entry to the Show is open to anyone, not exclusively Egmanton residents
- 2 All classes are open.
- Only **one** exhibit in each class per person not to have been shown in previous shows.
- 4 All exhibits must be made or grown or produced by the exhibitor.
- 5 All exhibits to be credited to an individual. No group entries accepted
- Jams, jellies & chutneys should be made in the 12 months preceding the date of the Show. Lemon curd to be no more than a month old. All entries to be dated.
- 7 Entry fee for all classes is 50p. Children may enter any class in the Show free of charge.
- 8 Staging will take place Saturday morning 2nd September in the Village Hall between 9:30am and 11:30am under the direction of the stewards.

9 Please have your exhibits staged by 11:30am.

- 10 Exhibitors to provide own receptacles for staging. The stewards will not be responsible for damage or theft of exhibits but will take every precaution to prevent injury or loss.
- 11 The decision of the judges is final.
- 12 Prize giving will take place at 4.15pm prompt.
- 13 Exhibits may be removed after 4:30pm.


