

**REPORT OF SOCIAL SERVICES SUB-COMMITTEE MEETING HELD
ON 2ND MARCH 2022 AT THE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY CONFERENCE
HALL, KADE**

The Social Services Sub-committee met on Wednesday, 2nd March, 2022 and deliberated on several issues and came out with the following recommendations:

1. POOR AND INADEQUATE FURNITURE IN BASIC SCHOOLS

Members raised much concerns over poor and inadequate furniture for some basic school children and their teachers after GES presented some affected schools on Power Point to them.

- (a) The committee members recommended that future distribution of furniture to basic schools should be channelled through the Municipal Education Directorate to make proper prioritization for sharing.**
- (b) Members again suggested and recommended that Parents through PTA should be made to support in the provision of desks to pupils.**

2. POOR PERFORMANCE AT BECE

After lengthy deliberations on the above issue

- (a) The Committee recommended that Punishment should be given to teachers who help students to cheat during exams to deter others from doing so.**
- (b) The committee suggested and recommended formation of Community Education committees to see to handle educational related issues at the community level.**

3. MECHANISATION OF BOREHOLE FOR KWAMANG CLINIC

The Committee recommends that the Assembly should top-up with the funds mobilised from the sale of water in the community to mechanise the nearest borehole and extend potable water supply to the clinic to enhance health delivery in the community.
