

REPORT OF SOCIAL SERVICES SUB-COMMITTEE MEETING
HELD ON 15th JUNE, 2022 AT THE MUNICIPAL AGRIC
CONFERENCE HALL, KADE

1. FURNITURE IN SCHOOLS

Members of the Sub-Committee discussed about inadequate school furniture in some schools within the Municipality, despite the Assembly's effort in the provision of furniture to some schools.

The Committee therefore recommends the Assembly to provide enough furniture to the remaining Schools which have similar challenges.

2. ATTITUDE OF TRICYCLE (PLAGIA) RIDERS AT ASUOM & KADE

After a lengthy discussion of how Tricycle riders behave in Kade and Asuom townships with **reckless riding, over loading and wrong packing (especially around the Hospital Junction to the Bus Stop)** without proper control from the Community Police Officers.

Members recommended that the Municipal Assembly in conjunction with the Police Commanders of these two towns should take it up and find proper solutions to curb the behaviour of the riders

3. CELEBRATION OF CHILD LABOUR DAY

The Department of Social Welfare and Community Development brought up an issue of celebrating Child Labour Day in the Municipality and explained to members that the Municipal had not celebrated such an activity before.

Members discussed and came out with the recommendation that, the Municipal Assembly should make provision in the next year's budget 2023 for celebration.
