Chapter Updates

The results are in from the chapter survey. We had a 28% response from the chapter. Which was higher than the recent in-person participation of 10%-20%. The more important part was what the participants had to say.

Here is the breakdown: There was a good split of perspectives, half who answered have been in the chapter for over 5 years and the other half have been in the chapter for 3 years or less. 86% prefer email communications. Over 70% joined for the camardarie and to meet more female pilots. What members enjoy about being a Ninety-Nine are: promoting aviation, friendships/connections, getting together for aviation and social events. A summary of what respondants would like to see from the chapter are more Austin events, variety in location, mentoring, more events overall, and even a suggetion for more online availability. There were 45% who responded that they are interested in doing anything and everything whether it is getting together for aviation or non-aviation related events. The next two most popular suggestions for topics/programs is the desire to work with kids/Girl Scouts, and to have speakers talk their aviation experiences. The one survey result that is going to prove to be a challenge is that only 3 members replied that they are willing to volunteer for a committee or chair position.

So, that's the sitch! We will try to plan monthly get-togthers and ensure they are diverse in location and activity. As a group, if we can get a commitment from memers to bring just one person with them to each event we can double the amount of participation. It's a fact that if we want to do larger events like host Girl Scouts, fundraising evets, etc., we need people. I can see the desire is there to hang out with our avgeek gal-pals (and guy-pals), but it does take a little effort whether it be inviting a new friend, an old friend, a co-worker, having a spouse or significant other become a 49 $\frac{1}{2}$ or a Friend of the 99s.
