The services we offer are highlighted below.

Early wedding planning...

- Discuss what your ideal wedding looks like with your partner
- Set a budget
- Start planning the guest list (this will impact your venue and budget)
- Pick potential wedding dates (check for clashes with important guests)
- Research wedding venues and ceremony locations
- Contact TABLES about catering and/or planning your engagement party

12 months before your wedding

- Pop the question to your bridal party
- Enlist any wedding help from family or friends (cake, flowers, dresses etc)
- Define your wedding theme/style and consider venue and ceremony decor
- 0 Research wedding dresses
- Send Save the Date cards
- Research wedding vendors (photographer, florist, invitations, cake, decor, music, hair and makeup)
- Consider wedding insurance options
- Decide on entertainment for ceremony and reception
- Book photographer and videographer
- Visit and book your reception venue and ceremony location, or contact TABLES for our venue partners
- Consider a wedding planner or stylist or contact TABLES about our styling and planning services
- Contact TABLES for our network of partners and recommended suppliers

8-10 months before

- Book musicians for the ceremony and reception
- O Book accommodation for guests
- 0 Book honeymoon
- 0 Order wedding cake
- О Register for gifts
- Contact decor companies if you need to hire chairs, tables and a marguee, or talk to TABLES about our 'hire and style' services
- Book your caterer and pay a deposit to secure the date

6-8 months before

- Order wedding dress to avoid 'rush fees'
- О Start planning honeymoon
- Ensure passports will be 'in date' for honeymoon
- Start planning hen and stag parties

4-6 months before

- Choose bridal party attire
- Choose and order wedding invitations and stationery
- 0 Meet with florist to discuss options
- 0 Shop for groom's suit
- 0 Rent the groomsmens' attire
- 0 Organize the legalities — give at least 3 months' notice to registrar/celebrant
- 0 Arrange travel vaccinations if necessary
- Organize wedding transport 0
- 0 Compile guest addresses and create spreadsheet for RSVPs
- 0 Organize a hair trial and book hairdresser
- 0 Organize a makeup trial and book a makeup artist
- Have your TABLES menu tasting and finalize menu, tableware and styling

2-3 months before

- 0 Send wedding invites
- 0 Choose and order wedding rings
- 0 Attend dress fittings
- Organize gifts for parents, bridesmaids, groomsmen and each other
- Organize outfits for flower girls or page boys
- 0 Buy shoes and accessories allow longer if ordering online

1 Day before

- Organize payment of any final invoices
- If BYO beverages, ensure it is at the venue and being chilled
- Ensure the cake is on track to be delivered to the reception venue
- 0 Ceremony rehearsal (allow for up to 90 minutes)
- Style the venue and set tables, or if TABLES is doing this, relax and...
- Get a good night's rest

Your Wedding Day



- If BYO beverages, ensure your caterers know what to serve and when
- Give rings to the best man to hold during the ceremony
- Deliver flowers and buttonholes to the wedding party

After your Wedding Day (9)



- Return any rental equipment you haven't hired through TABLES
- O Write and send thank-you notes
- 0 Collect your marriage certificate
- If BYO beverages, collect left-overs and empty bottles, or if you've arranged your beverages through TABLES, we'll do it
