# **RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

Please report to Bio Security Officer before unloading lorry to ensure adherence to the current DEFRA Regulations. All cattle entered must produce TB clearance certificates if applicable.

Cattle must have a valid PASSPORT and MOVEMENT CERTIFICATE on the day. No lorries to be unloaded until advised. Please make sure all wheel arches on all vehicles are disinfected before arrival on the showground.

# Please use special Livestock entrance on the day.

All animals must be HALTER TRAINED AND LED or remain in pen. All exhibitors must comply with MOVEMENT DOCUMENTATION to the satisfaction of Surrey Trading Standards.

All exhibitors must fill in ENTRY FORMS.

All Cattle are to be on showground by 9.00am, with judging commencing at 10.00am on Saturday and 11.00am on Sunday.

# JUDGES FOR BOTH DAYS TO BE ADVISED

All cattle should remain until after the Grand Parade in the Main Ring on both days.
